WORSHIPPING

IN-PERSON WORSHIP

Our 9am service in the Sanctuary is beginning to look more familiar. The latest adjustments:

- **No Health Screening**
- **No Registration/Check-In**
- **No Social Distancing**
- **Singing / Response** – Allowed, but unvaccinated individuals must remain masked.
- **Live Music** – Yet to be determined.
- **No Masks for Fully Vaccinated** - A person is considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after completion of a two-dose series or single dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.
- **Unvaccinated** – The mask requirement still applies which protects children and people still vulnerable.

According to the newest guidelines, vaccine verification has been left to the discretion of individual organizations and businesses. Geneva leadership has chosen to trust that worship attendees will honor the face covering requirements spelled out here. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
